Dear Colleague,

Greetings to the GRMF Community!

Inspiring our clients to “press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus” (Phi 3:14) is one of the most challenging issues we face in the ministry of Rescue. As the homeless look at their lives and contemplate their future, discouragement often sets in. The future often looks hopeless and bleak. Inspiring our clients to have “hope” is a challenge beyond human strength. It truly is a work of the Spirit.

Yet in the ministry of Rescue, this is what God has called us to do. One of the great tools that God has given us is the “Doctrine of Vocation.” The idea that God has called and gifted all men into some meaningful labor in life. But God has not limited His callings to jobs; God has called us into the body of Christ. He has called us to families. He has called us to friends and neighborhoods, and so much more. It is our duty to help our clients see how the sovereign God uses “all things” (Including the bad things) in their lives for His glory. FEATURED MISSION

Hands of Faith Native Ministries Intl.

Hands of Faith Ministries (HFM) is located on a 8 acre campus 4 miles south of White Clay, Nebraska a village of population 17 people. It is 5 miles from the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation with a population of 14,000 Oglala Lakota, in South Dakota. Oglala Lakota county has one of the highest extreme poverty levels in the US.

Hands of Faith has a 16 bed facility, men's program only, with vocational training in hands on construction skills: electrical, carpentry/woodworking, machine operations. Building and repairing homes and churches is also a part of the program.



Our primary goal is helping Native men grow in their relationship to Jesus Christ, by becoming the (Priest) of their family, provider (job), and protector (loving father).

A new men's facility was completed in 2019 and also serves to host group meetings and a church on Saturday night led by a two brothers who were once clients at HFM.



Mission teams, helping to do projects, are a main source of support, coming from many parts of the U.S. Pictured below is the Pine Ridge Gospel Fellowship Church re-roofing project, and above is our 2021 mission

house which is nearly completed for staff or mission teams, including 3 RV hookups. Clients and former clients did the majority of the building. We praise the Lord for His Great Faithfulness. In 2021 HFM also distributed \$30,000 in \$50 food vouchers to needy families on Pine Ridge reservation.
