### COLUMBUS RESCUE MISSION

The Columbus & Living Water Rescue Mission exists to help the hurting and the homeless in the name of Jesus Christ in Columbus and York, Nebraska and surrounding communities for the glory of God. Our number one priority is the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are a small mission with 25 beds at each location, in Columbus and York, where we serve men, women, and families. Our women's Healing Heart discipleship program is at our York location and men's New Life Program is in Columbus.



The year 2021 was a monumental year for the Columbus & Living Water Rescue Mission. The Lord has touched many lives through the ministry in its current location in Columbus but we have often lacked space for families, guests, and New Life Program participants. Our multiple

levels have made things very difficult for many guests and volunteers as well. In God's Providence through special donations from a few donors we were able to purchase a former nursing home outright. This will triple our current space and will be all on one floor! There is lots of work to be done, as the building suffered significant water damage due to a burst fire sprinkler system but God is faithful and we know He will see us through.
